The Spectrum Hearing Brand is continued on the pillars of our brand that has been around for 14 years:

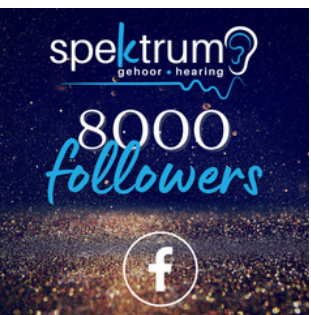
- The legacy of a practice that has been known for superb and quality service delivery.

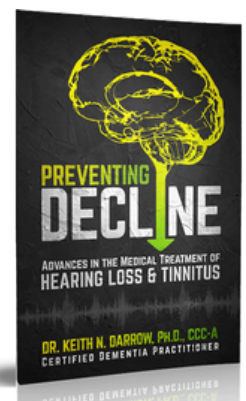
THE APPF SUMMIT

The Audiologist Private Practice Forum (APPF) hosted the APPF Summit during August and we were treated with a panel of amazing international and local experts:

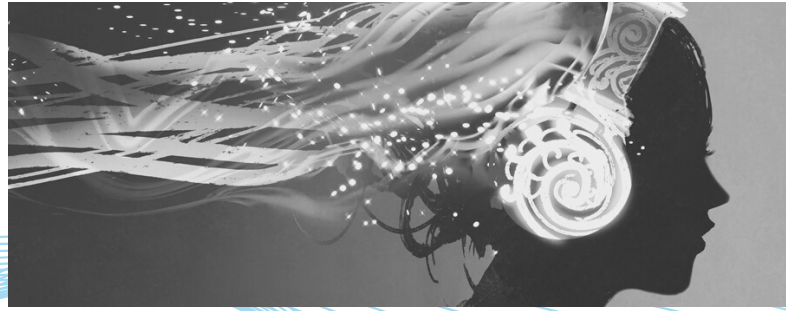
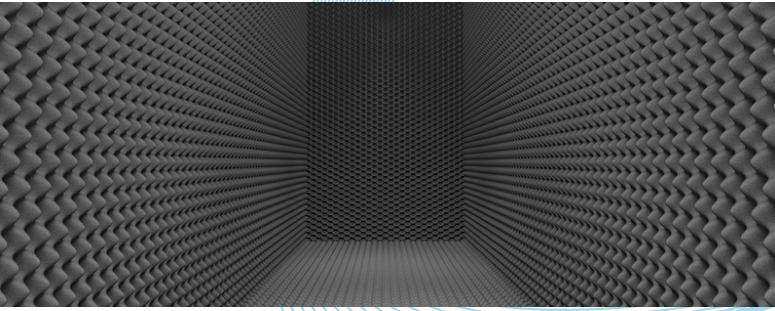
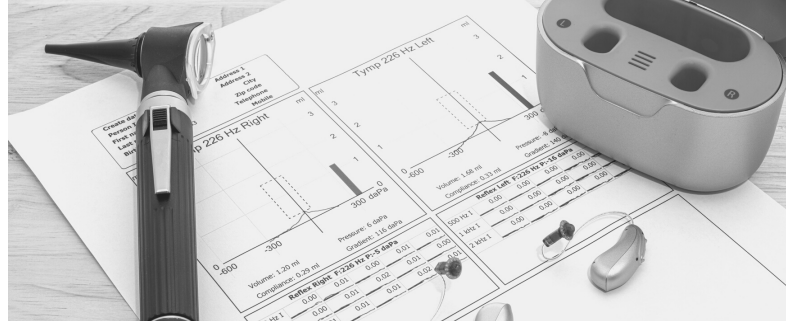
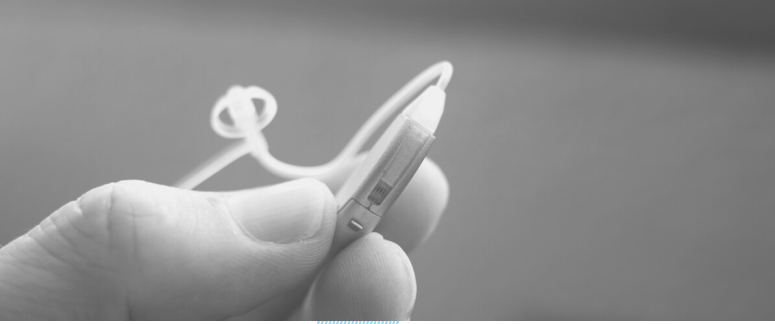

Spectrum Hearing Industrial

Hearing Screenings in industrial industries are required by law, when noise exposure exceeds 85dB. We perform on-site screenings at industries to ensure little time out of the working environment for employees. Diagnostic hearing assessments are performed on individuals with a 10% shift in PLH (Percentage Loss of Hearing) scores.

We have numerous companies that we screen annually and have built long lasting relationships with. We have expanded our services to other provinces of South Africa. Modern equipment allows us to be more efficient and conduct the screening in a timeous manner. The company where we are conducting the screening will receive a full report on each employee tested and we keep all records for 10 years or more.



Hear. OUT

Hearing Aids are known to be quite a financial layout. We always strive to keep devices as affordable as possible to ensure that everyone that needs a device can afford to have one. Since we understand the importance on multi levels of treating hearing loss as soon as possible, we do also know that making use of premium technology benefits a patient much more than basic technology.

As a part of the drive to ensure that everyone can afford to use hearing devices, we introduced an in-house payment plan for devices, which allows a patient to pay off their instruments over a period of 12 months, after an initial 50% deposit. This arrangement has assisted numerous individuals to obtain hearing instruments which they otherwise would not be able to afford.



Auditory Processing Centre

Auditory Processing Disorder (APD) is a disruption in the auditory nervous system's network that can affect the brain's ability to process sound accurately and efficiently. Individuals with APD can have normal hearing sensitivity and will pass a basic hearing test, but processing and understanding what is heard are compromised. It is often that the ears and brain do not fully coordinate and this lack of coordination can interfere with the brain's ability to recognize and interpret sound. APD can make it hard to distinguish small sound differences within words, remember what was heard, and keep up with ongoing speech, especially in background noise or where more than one person is talking. A breakdown in listening skills disrupt the normal acquisition of language and can cause speech/language delays and difficulties communicating. APD is treatable. Some types of APD can be completely remediated within a few months.

Spectrum Hearing - Auditory Processing Center specializes in the assessment and treatment of auditory processing disorder. APD evaluations can be performed for children ages five and up, and adults can also be seen for APD testing and therapy. Therapy through Auditory Processing Center is highly individualized based on each person's specific deficits. By customizing treatment and addressing any coexisting issues, children and adults can improve their listening skills, regain confidence, and reach their full potential.


